GETTING AROUND

WAIHEKE ALL DAY BUS PASS

This comes free with all our tours, but can be bought separately for \$8 – ask at the Ticket Office when you buy your ferry ticket. It allows you unlimited travel on all public bus services for that day.

ISLAND BUS TRANSPORT

Public bus services meet all ferries and depart from just outside the ferry terminal (taxi wait here too). Bus timetables are available from the Waiheke ferry terminal. Buses are numbered: Oneroa village any bus, Onetangi Beach 1, 3 & 4, Palm Beach & Rocky Bay 2 & 3, Surfdale/Ostend 1, 3 & 4.

Taste the best of Waiheke food and wine on this delicious tour. Enjoy a day sampling luscious local fare that will make your taste buds tingle. This tour includes wine and olive tasting at three vineyards and an olive estate.

On arrival at the island you will be greeted by your tour driver and taken first to Stonyridge Vineyard for a tour and tastings, plus a light lunch of frittata and fresh seasonal salad.

You will then depart for the award winning Rangihoua Estate for some olive tasting, followed by a stop at Wild on Waiheke, which offers optional beer tasting as well as wine. You'll also get to sample locally produced food; olive oils and preserves.

The tour concludes with tastings at the beautiful Mudbrick Vineyard whilst enjoying stunning views over the Hauraki Gulf. You can then choose to use your complimentary All Day Bus Pass to further explore the island, or else take the ferry directly back to Auckland.



ABOUT THE ISLAND

This stunning island is approximately 40 minutes away by ferry from downtown Auckland and boasts 92 square km of beautiful beaches, vineyards, olive groves, art galleries and laid back seaside villages. It's a great day out from Auckland as well as a superb holiday destination. From ocean kayaking and mountain biking to bush walking and picnics on the beach, there are many ways to enjoy the island's natural beauty.

VINEYARDS

No visit to Waiheke is complete without enjoying some local wine tasting. With its ideal growing conditions of hot dry summers and stony soils, Waiheke produces some of New Zealand's best red wines. Several vineyards also have excellent restaurants.

BEACHES

The best beaches on the island are on Waiheke's north coast. Oneroa, Little Oneroa, Palm Beach and Onetangi Beach are all great for swimming.

COASTAL WALKS

Scenic coastal walks reveal sensational views of surrounding islands and the Coromandel, as well as Waiheke's beautiful coastline. A leaflet with maps of island walks is available from the ferry terminal at Matiatia. Two coastal walks can be done from Matiatia wharf – turn either left or right as you leave the wharf and follow the green and yellow signs.

ART TRAIL

Waiheke is known for its art as well as its wine – for details on island galleries and studios that are open to the public, pick up a Waiheke Arts Trail leaflet from the ferry terminal.
