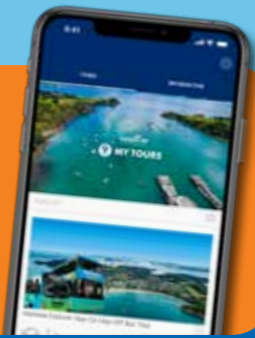

This unique and cost-effective hop-on hop-off tour gives you the flexibility and freedom to visit popular vineyards, beaches, seaside villages and island activities. Your friendly, local host will provide a guided commentary on the island's history and culture so you get a real insider view of island life.

HOP-ON HOP-OFF

An Explorer bus will depart approximately every 60 minutes and the timetable has been carefully designed so that you can visit key locations through 17 convenient stops across the island.

This means all you need to think about is where you want to spend your day discovering gourmet food, award-winning wines, beaches, bush walks, galleries and boutique shopping amongst a backdrop of stunning scenery. With the flexibility of the hop-on hop-off explorer, you can stay for as long or as little as you like.

VINEYARDS
