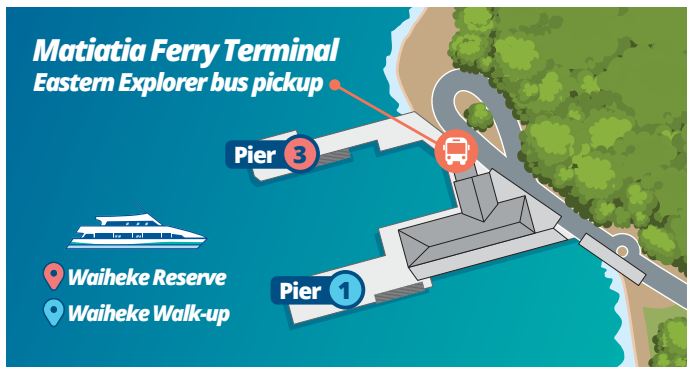
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EASTERN EXPLORER BUS

A flexible way to explore Waiheke Island's best-kept secret. Travel at your own pace as the Eastern Explorer bus takes you to the island's lesser-known eastern end, a side of Waiheke where world-class vineyards, boutique distilleries, and rich history meet some of the country's most spectacular views.

Tour details

- The Eastern Explorer departs from Matiatia Ferry Terminal every 30-60 minutes depending on the season. Explore each stop at your leisure or stay aboard for a 110-minute scenic loop. Along the way, your driver-guide shares fascinating stories, island history, and insider tips to help shape your perfect day.
- **Discover the flavours of Waiheke Island:** Highlights include the historic Stony Batter Tunnels, Man O' War Vineyard, Waiheke Distilling Co., Passage Rock Wines, and Jasper Ridge Winery; each offering a distinctive experience that brings this side of the island to life.
- **Duration:** We recommend allowing a full day, including ferry travel to and from downtown Auckland.
- **Departure time:** Each Eastern Explorer bus arrives at Matiatia Ferry Terminal to meet the ferry. The first bus meets the 9am sailing from downtown Auckland. The final bus will return passengers to the ferry terminal to meet the 6:00pm sailing back to downtown Auckland.
- **Ferry travel:** For certainty, book the Waiheke Reserve ferry for guaranteed seating and priority boarding. Prefer flexibility? The Waiheke Walk-up ferry lets you travel on demand, just plan to arrive at least 60 minutes before departure, especially during busy summer days.

Some vineyards may close from time to time. In these instances, the Eastern Explorer bus will not stop at these destinations. Advanced bookings are advisable for Fullers360 tours. If you are planning to dine on Waiheke Island, please book the venue in advance of travel to avoid disappointment. For Waiheke Walk-up services, arrive at the Downtown Ferry Terminal at least 30 minutes prior to ferry departure for boarding. In summer, we recommend allowing at least 60 minutes. All departures and timetables are subject to change or cancellation. Prices in this brochure are correct at time of printing and inclusive of GST, and may change without notice.
