A flexible and cost-effective way to experience Waiheke Island. Simply hop on and hop off at the island's top spots including vineyards, beaches, seaside villages, galleries, shops and cafés.

#### **Tour details**

- The Western Explorer buses depart daily from Matiatia Ferry Terminal every 30 minutes. The timetable has been designed to visit key locations with 16 convenient stops. If you prefer, stay on board and enjoy a scenic 80 minute tour with your friendly driver/quide talking you through the island's history and insider tips to help plan your trip.
- Tourist hotspots: Discover the best spots across the island for shopping and relaxing - including Oneroa Village and the stunning Onetangi Beach.
- **Duration:** We recommend allowing at least half a day, including ferry travel to and from downtown Auckland.
- **Departure time:** Each Western Explorer Hop-On Hop-Off bus arrives at Matiatia Ferry Terminal to meet sailings as they arrive, the first bus meets the 9am sailing from downtown Auckland. The final bus will return passengers to the ferry terminal to meet the 7pm sailing back to downtown Auckland.
- Ferry travel: For certainty, book the Waiheke Reserve ferry for guaranteed seating and priority boarding. Prefer flexibility? The Waiheke Walk-up ferry lets you travel on demand, just plan to arrive at least 60 minutes before departure, especially during busy summer days.


